NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 Racing rule 40.1 will be changed as follows: All competitors are required to wear a life jacket or other adequate personal floatation device while racing.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The following classes are invited to participate: 1D35, Express 37, J/120 and J/105.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form located at www.stfyc.com. Forms must be submitted by March 12, 2008 to avoid late fee.
- 2.3 Fleets must have six boats registered by the entry deadline (March 12th) to qualify for a class start.

3.0 FEES

- 3.1 Entry fee is \$85, less \$5 with proof of current USSA membership, if **received by March 12, 2008**.
- 3.2 Entry fee is \$95, less \$5 with proof of current USSA membership, if received **after March 12, 2008**.

4.0 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Late Registration: Saturday, March 15, 2008 from 930 hours to 1000 hours.
- 4.2 Racing will be held on Saturday, March 15 & Sunday, March 16, 2008.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the Warning Signal for the first race each day is 1100 hours. A Sailors' Meeting will be held at 1000 hours on Saturday, March 15, 2008.
- 4.4 Participants and their guests are welcome to attend a complimentary social on Saturday evening, and a trophy ceremony following the conclusion of racing on Sunday.

5.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the check-in before the Sailors' Meeting, while an unofficial copy may be found on the StFYC web site by Wednesday, March 12, 2008.

6.0 RACING AREA

The intended race area will be set on the City Front utilizing inflatable marks.

7.0 SCORING

- 7.1 One race will constitute a series.
- 7.2 Four races are scheduled in the series, with two on Saturday and two on Sunday, all of which will count in a boats final score.

8.0 BERTHING

All yachts competing in the event may be moored free of charge at the StFYC guest docks one night prior to the beginning of racing and one night after racing concludes.

9.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
