Class Rule 7.1 (rev. 2022)

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The maximum crew weight (in swimming apparel) for one-design racing is 500 kilograms (1102 lbs.) with no limit on numbers of crew except that a crew of up to 6 members with 3 or more women has no restriction on crew weight. An Owner who is the sole Driver for a regatta may elect a weight of 100 kg (220 lbs.) for that regatta, in which case he or she shall not be subject to weigh-in or other weight check. If the sailing instructions require a weigh-in prior to the start of a regatta, a boat complying with the weight restrictions at weigh-in shall not otherwise be subject to a weigh-in during or after the regatta, except for weighing substitute crew.
