Rolf reports that he still does not have SFYC dates from the Club and does not expect them for another month. StFYC has embraced the concept of separate starts for "B fleet" at regatta's selected by J/105 Fleet. There was discussion on how a B series championship could be constructed and what the parameters might be, such as top 10 Fleet boats being made ineligible for B series championship scoring. No action item was recorded on this topic. Ned will take lead next year to drum up interest in the B series.

J/105 Invitational Sausalito: much discussion regarding the event and whether we should search for an alternative host Club. Action: Discussion focused in particular on 'post racing' activities as everyone agreed that the racing was fine. Rolf will investigate alternatives as well as discuss further with Sausalito how to improve the event. He will also look into alternatives for hosting a J/105 only regatta.

Conclusions:

No vote was held because the schedule is incomplete. Rolf will continue to work on it and report back to the membership as regattas and dates are settled upon.

Agenda item: Rules Proposals Presenter: Ned

The following rules were discussed and voted:

2013-01. Class (Regatta Committee) can modify rules for individual regattas/events.

Voted YES. Unanimous

- 2. 2013-02. Two jibs may be carried on the boat when racing. Voted NO. Tally: N=16, Y=2, A=1
- 3. 2013-03. No shims at partners. Voted YES. Unanimous
- 4. 2013-04. Grammatical Correction Voted YES. Unanimous
- 5. 2013-05. Effective date of new rules JAN 1. Voted YES. Unanimous

Agenda item: Local Fleet Rules vs National Rules Presenter: Ned

National Fleet is asking that we bring our local rules into alignment with National Fleet Rules.

Discussion surrounded the general feeling that we have unique circumstances in the Bay area that call for this divergence. Fleet Voted to ask the Executive Committee to convene a special committee to investigate, and to report back to the membership, the following:

- a) whether it is appropriate for our Fleet to have rules the conflict with National Class rules;
- b) if not, are there Fleet rules that need to be changed to bring our Fleet into compliance.
